

The following SOP is planned for issuance of Admit Cards to candidates who do not have a valid NTS GAT (General) score.

1. All such candidates will purchase the postgraduate prospectus.
2. They will fill the on-line application form and choose "Not yet appeared" in place of NTS GAT (General) score.
3. They will submit their applications in the concerned departments. The departments will issue them a receipt with a roll number as for all other applicants.
4. The departments have been given the option to print the Admit Card for the candidate, if they so desire.
5. The candidates can print their Admit Card themselves by logging on to the admission portal and choosing "Get Admit Card" option. They will be asked about their CNIC number and the roll number issued by the department. Candidates applying in multiple departments will enter any one roll number. Their Admit Card will be generated on-line which may be printed by the candidate.
6. Possession of Admit Card and CNIC is compulsory at the time of appearing in the GAT (General) Test.
7. The venue of the test is UET Auditorium Complex. All candidates will be advised to bring their Clip Boards as there are no writing arms on the chairs available in the complex.
